


Good morning, Kitty!


I have a very special breakfast for you today!


But . . . uh . . . there is one teeny, tiny, little thing you have to do today, Kitty. Try to stay calm, okay? We have an appointment for you to get a . . .








Are you okay?




KITTY!

You don't want to get sick, do you?


You do?!





But a vaccine can prevent that.



. . . **VET!**




LATER, AT THE VET'S OFFICE . . .

I'm glad you're asking me questions, Kitty. Asking your doctor questions is always a good idea!


Is there anything else you want to ask me?

No, Kitty. The vaccine won't turn you into a dog.




No, Kitty. The vaccine won't transform you into a mindless robot. The vaccine won't change you in any way!

Good!








I'm very proud of you, Kitty! I know you were nervous about getting that shot, but once you understood how important it was, you were very brave and did the right thing.
